The **Ca' Borin Library** provides users with resources from two disciplinary areas (**Economics and Geography**) as well as **social sciences journals**.



reading rooms

Reading rooms are accessible by **seat reservation (Affluences)**, on the first floor of Ca' Borin building.

Ca' Borin Library offers also **6 computers** connected to the University network (for the access to electronic resources). Access is limited to **institutional users** (unipd.it).



borrowing books

The University Library lends different numbers of books to different categories of readers.

The service can be used by **all University users** and guest users with a Library System Card.

document delivery service (article request)

If you didn't find in Padova libraries what you were looking for, you can use the [NILDE Document Delivery service](#). Through this service, Ca' Borin Libraries supply their users with copies of documents, such as journal articles, book chapters etc, not available in Padova.



wifi connection

[Eduroam Wi-Fi net](#) provides teachers and students with easy and secure access to the network. Authentication is performed by their home institution, using the same credentials provided by it (SSO).

looking for books and journals?

Search [GalileoDiscovery](#), a new and innovative tool which allows the research of books, journals, and articles owned by the libraries of Padua.

Using GalileoDiscovery and its advanced filters, you can quickly find the information you are looking for: the availability of copies, in which libraries you can find them, their position on the shelf and whether borrowing is allowed.

Books are mostly on open shelves.



journals

- **Current issue** are on the first-floor shelves and they are placed in alphabetical order. **Back issues** are on the ground floor.
- Journals and magazines **cannot be borrowed**, you can photocopy them according to copyright laws, only for personal use and research.

The same rule are applied to the **printing and downloading of electronic journals** and other copyrighted materials.

Please note: library paper materials can be freely read in the library. Other services are intended for institutional users and users with a SBA card.
